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CHEVRON SHAWL

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EP47

This chevron triangle shawl features an angled neckline. Easy garter stitch is combined with basic short rows and simple increases and decreases. Shawl is worked from the bottom up to the neckline. The pattern is for fingering weight yarn and is offered in two sizes.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

SMALL

Length, point to point at neckline 117 cm / 46"
Depth at center, neckline to bottom 40.5 cm / 16"

LARGE

Length, point to point at neckline 117 cm / 46"
Depth at center, neckline to bottom 61 cm / 24"

MATERIALS

YARN

- URTH UNEEK FINGERING, 100% extra fine superwash merino, approx 400 m / 438 yds and 100 g / 3½ oz per skein
- SMALL: 1 skein, col: 3002
- LARGE: 2 skeins, col: 3013

NEEDLES and NOTIONS

- One pair of needles size 3.75 mm / US 5 or size to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker (removable or split-ring)
- Optional: 6 - 8 ring markers used during cast on
- Yarn needle
- Blocking board and pins

GAUGE

22 sts and 44 rows = 10 cm / 4" over garter stitch, blocked (Note: this is an intentionally loose tension)

GARTER STITCH

All rows: Knit.

ABBREVIATIONS

K - knit

Rep - repeat

RS - right side

St(s) - stitch (es)

WS - wrong side

GLOSSARY

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together - Right leaning decrease of 1 stitch. Knit 2 stitches together as one.

KFB: knit front and back - increase one stitch. Knit the next stitch but do not remove from LH needle, insert tip of RH needle behind the LH needle and knit into the back of the same stitch. Slip both from LH needle.

S2KP: slip 2 stitches, knit 1 stitch and pass slipped stitches over - Centered double decrease. Slip next 2 stitches together as one, knitwise to RH needle, knit 1 stitch, then pass the two slipped stitches together over the knit stitch.

SKP: slip 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch, pass slip stitch over - Left leaning decrease of 1 stitch. Slip next stitch knitwise to RH needle, knit next stitch, and then pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch.

W&T - Wrap and turn. Knit up to stitch to be wrapped, slip stitch to RH needle, yarn forward, slip stitch back to LH needle, turn work and continue to knit next row. There is no need to knit stitch with wrap later, when working this stitch.

NOTES

- Instructions are given for the SMALL size first, changes for LARGE size follow in parenthesis. Where there is only one figure, it applies to both sizes, unless otherwise noted.
- Right side and wrong side are designated for convenience only, finished shawl is completely reversible.
- To avoid color pooling, stagger the color sequence by cutting off and discarding the first meter / yard of the first color, before casting on.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 349 (437) sts. Use stitch markers every 50 sts, to help with counting. Remove counters once stitch count is achieved.

ZIG ZAG BOTTOM EDGE

Row 1 (RS): K174 (218) sts, mark next stitch as center st, with removable marker and k to end. Continue to reposition removable marker on marked stitch as work progresses.

SIZE SMALL ONLY

Row 2 (WS): SKP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, S2KP, k7, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, k4, KFB, KFB, k4, k2tog. 347 sts now on needle.

Row 3 (RS): SKP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, S2KP, k5, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, k4, KFB, KFB, k4, k2tog. 345 sts now on needle.

Row 4 (WS): SKP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, S2KP, k3, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, k4, KFB, KFB, k4, k2tog. 343 sts now on needle.

Row 5 (RS): SKP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4 [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, S2KP, k1, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 12 times, k4, KFB, KFB, k4, k2tog. 341 sts now on needle.

Row 6 (WS): Knit.

Continue from **SHORT ROW SECTION 2**.

SIZE LARGE ONLY

Row 2 (WS): K4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, S2KP, k7, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, k4, cast on 1 st. 434 sts now on needle.

Row 3 (RS): K4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, S2KP, k5, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, k3, cast on 2 sts. 432 sts now on needle.

Row 4 (WS): K4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, S2KP, k3, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, k3, cast on 2 sts. 430 sts now on needle.

Row 5 (RS): K4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, S2KP, k1, S2KP, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 16 times, k3, cast on 1 st. 427 sts now on needle.

Row 6 (WS): knit.

SHORT ROW SECTION 1

* **Row 1 (RS):** K to 1 st before center st, S2KP, k to last 4 sts, W&T. (Always leave unworked sts at end of needle)

Row 2 (WS): K to last 4 sts, W&T.

Row 3 (RS): K to 1 st before center st, S2KP, k to 4 sts less than last RS row, W&T.

Row 4 (WS): K to 4 sts less than last WS row, W&T.
**

Continue to repeat rows 3 and 4, 40 more times.

7 sts remain at center.

Next row (RS): K3, S2KP, k to end of row. 341 sts now on needle.

Next row (WS): K to end of row.

SHORT ROW SECTION 2

341 sts are now on needle

Repeat from * to ** of **SHORT ROW SECTION 1**. Then continue to repeat rows 3 and 4, 31 more times.

11 sts remain at center.

Next row (RS): K4, S2KP, k to end of row. 273 sts now on needle.

Next row (WS): K to end of row.

SHORT ROW SECTION 3

273 sts are now on needle

Repeat from * to ** of **SHORT ROW SECTION 1**. Then continue to repeat rows 3 and 4, 25 more times.

3 sts remain at center.

Next row (RS): S2KP, k to end of row. 217 sts now on needle.

Next row (WS): K to end of row.

ZIG ZAG TOP EDGE

Row 1 (RS): K 107 sts, S2KP, k to end.

Next 4 rows: SKP, k7, KFB, KFB, k4, [S2KP, k4, KFB, KFB, k4] 15 times, k3, k2tog.

Next row (bind off): SKP and use as first stitch of bind off. Continue to bind off loosely until center 3 sts, S2KP, continue to bind off until last 2 sts on left hand needle, k2tog. Continue to bind off. Cut yarn and fasten off.

FINISHING

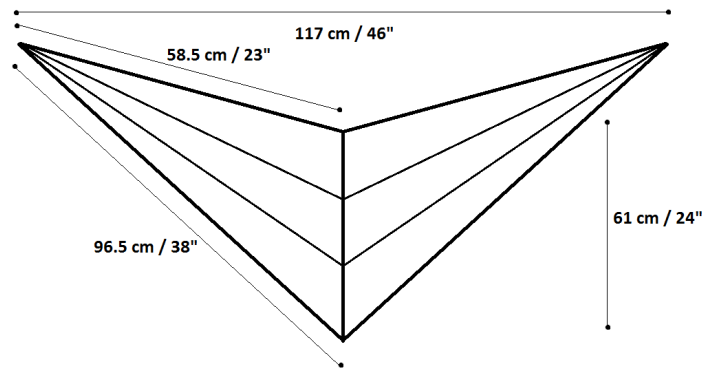
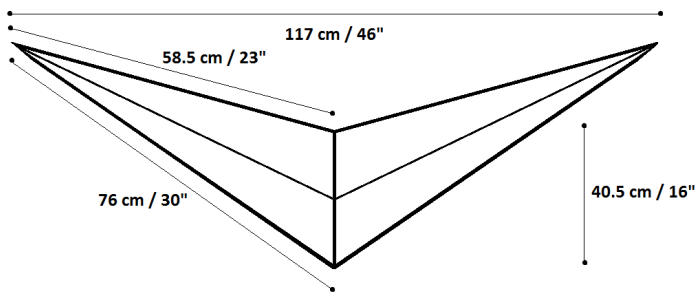
Wet block the shawl on blocking board. Carefully pin the points of ZIG ZAG edges and following given measurements. Weave in ends after blocking.
