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EP48

This circular capelet features delicate lace patterns that radiate naturally from the center neckline. One size will fit most.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference at neckline	81 cm / 32"
Circumference at bottom	239 cm / 94"
Depth from neckline to bottom	28 cm / 11"

MATERIALS

YARN

- 1 skein of URTH MONOKROM, 100% extra fine superwash merino, approx 400 m / 438 yds and 100 g / 3½ oz per skein
Shown in colour: 3052

NEEDLES and NOTIONS

- Circular needle size 2.75 mm / US 2, 60 cm / 24" long or size to obtain gauge
- Circular needle size 3.75 mm / US 5, 60 cm / 24" long or size to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Yarn needle
- Blocking board and pins

GAUGE

25 sts and 36 rounds = 10 cm / 4" over St st, with smaller needle, blocked

Worked with a loose tension:

16 sts and 28 rounds = 10 cm / 4" over lace pattern one, with larger needles, blocked

14 sts and 28 rounds = 10 cm / 4" over lace pattern two, with larger needles, blocked

13 sts and 28 rounds 10 cm / 4" over lace pattern three, with larger needles, blocked

STOCKING STITCH (St st)

All rounds: Knit.

ABBREVIATIONS

K - knit

LH - left hand

P - purl

PM - place marker

Rep - repeat

RH - right hand

RM - remove marker

Rnd - round

Sl - slip

St(s) - stitch (es)

Wyib - with yarn in back

Yo - yarn over

() - follow inside instructions as directed

[] - repeat inside instructions a specific number of times

GLOSSARY

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together - Right leaning decrease of 1 stitch. Knit 2 stitches together as one.

LIFTED INCREASE - Increase one stitch. In next stitch on LH needle, knit into the stitch from the row below (without slipping stitch off the needle), then knit into the stitch on the LH needle and slip off needle.

S2KP: slip 2 stitches, knit 1 stitch and pass slipped stitches over - Centered double decrease. Slip next 2 stitches together as one, knitwise to RH needle, knit 1 stitch, then pass the two slipped stitches together over the knit stitch.

SKP: slip 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over - Left leaning decrease of 1 stitch. Slip next stitch knitwise to RH needle, knit next stitch, and then pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch.

SK2P: slip 1 stitch, knit 2 stitches together, pass slipped stitches over - Left leaning double decrease. Slip next stitch knitwise to RH needle, knit next 2 stitches together, and then pass the slipped stitch over the resulting stitch from the knit 2 together.

INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needles, cast on 200 sts. Join into round taking care not to twist. Place marker for beginning of round.

PICOT EDGE (multiple of 2 sts)

Rnds 1 – 5: Knit.

Rnd 6 (fold line): [k2tog, yo] rep to end.

Change to larger needle.

Rnds 7 – 11: Knit.

Rnd 12 (join hem): Fold piece in half to inside from round 6 (wrong sides together) and put the right-hand needle into the first stitch on the needle as if to knit, then put needle through the first stitch of the cast on edge and knit these two "stitches" together. Repeat for each stitch, creating a hemmed double thickness.

Rnds 13 and 14: Knit.

200 sts now on needle.

LACE PATTERN ONE (multiple of 8 sts)

Rnd 1: [Yo, SKP, k3, k2tog, yo, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: [K1, yo, SKP, k1, k2tog, yo, k2] rep to end.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: [K2, yo, SK2P, yo, k2, p1] rep to end.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: [SKP, (k1, yo) twice, k1, k2tog, p1] rep to end.

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnds 9 – 16: Repeat rnds 7 and 8, 4 more times.

Rnds 17 – 22: Repeat rnds 1 – 6, one more time.

Next rnd: Knit.

Increase rnd: [K3, work lifted increase in next stitch] rep to end.

250 sts now on needle.

LACE PATTERN TWO (multiple of 10 sts)

Rnd 1: [Yo, SKP, k2tog, yo, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: [K1, yo, SKP, k3, k2tog, yo, k2] rep to end.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: [K2, yo, SKP, k1, k2tog, yo, k3] rep to end.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: [K3, yo, SK2P, yo, k4] rep to end.

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnd 9: [SKP, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, k2tog, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnds 11 – 14: Repeat rnds 9 and 10, 2 more times.

Rnds 15 – 22: Repeat rnds 1 – 8, one more time.

Next rnd: Knit.

Increase rnd: [K4, work lifted increase in next stitch] rep to end.

300 sts now on needle.

LACE PATTERN THREE (multiple of 12 sts)

Rnd 1: [Yo, SKP, k7, k2tog, yo, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: [K1, yo, SKP, k5, k2tog, yo, k2] rep to end.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: [(yo, SKP) twice, k3, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: [K1, (yo, SKP) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k2] rep to end.

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnd 9: [(yo, SKP) twice, yo, SK2P, yo, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnd 11: [K3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, SKP, k4] rep to end.

Rnd 12: Knit.

Rnd 13: [K2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, SKP, k3] rep to end.

Rnd 14: Knit.

Rnd 15: [K1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, SKP) twice, k2] rep to end.

Rnd 16: Knit.

Rnd 17: [(k2tog, yo) twice, k3, (yo, SKP) twice, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 18: Knit.

Rnd 19: RM, Sl1, PM, [yo (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, SKP) twice, yo, S2KP] rep to end.

Rnd 20: Knit.

Next rnd: Knit.

300 sts now on needle.

EYELET BORDER (multiple of 3 sts)

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: RM, wyib Sl1, PM, [yo, yo, S2KP] rep to end.

Rnd 3: [K1 in the first yo, p1 in the second yo, k1] rep to end.

Rnd 4: Purl.

Next rnd: Cast off purlwise, loosely.

FINISHING

Wet block the capelet on blocking board following given measurements. Carefully pin into a circle by placing pins along border at positions: half, then quarters, then eights, sixteenths, etc. Weave in yarn ends.
