



MANOS DEL URUGUAY

Fino Shadow Shawl

SIZE

Finished measurements: Approx. 69" across top edge, 31 ½" from center back neck to bottom point

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay FINO (70% extrafine merino, 30% silk; approx. 100g/490 yds), 1 sk MC plus 1 Miniskein Set. Shown in 436 Poison (MC) with kit 5 Eleanor (413 Rosewater [CC1], 421 Havisham [CC2], 411 Pocketwatch [CC3], 420 Boudoir [CC4], 410 Garnet Brooch [CC5]).

US 6/4mm circular ndl, 29" or longer, or size to obtain gauge
2 ring markers

GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows = 4" over Stripe Pattern, blocked (see Notes)

NOTES

- 17 sts and 32 rows = 4" is a blocked gauge. Before blocking, my gauge was 24 sts and 40 rows = 4". Because of the silk content, Fino relaxes quite a lot in blocking. If your gauge is too big before blocking, you may run out of yarn.
- Shawl is worked in 2-row stripes. There's no need to cut yarn at every color change; carry color not in use up side of work, making sure not to pull it too tight.

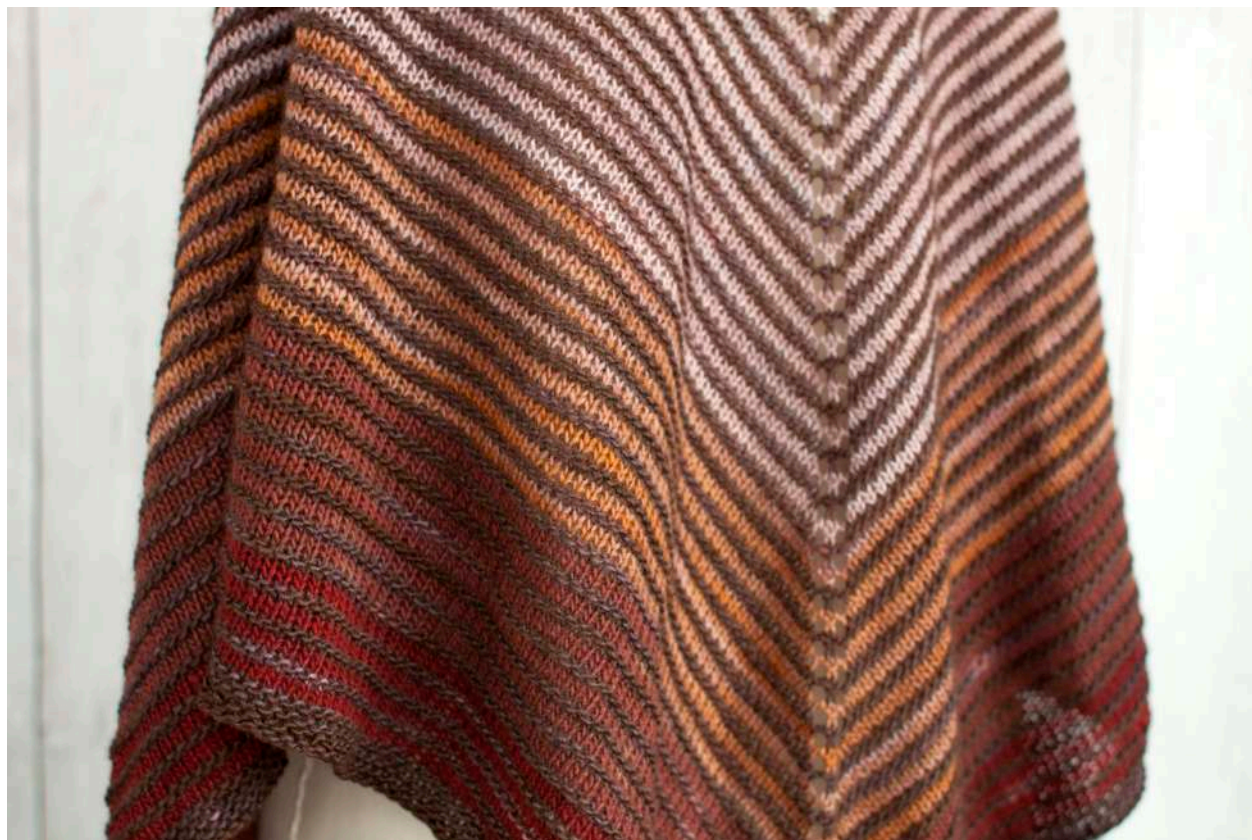
ABBREVIATIONS

CC: contrast color
CO: cast on
Inc(d): increase(d)
K: knit
M: marker
MC: main color
Pm: place marker
Rep: repeat
RS: right side
Sl: slip
St(s): stitch(es)
WS: wrong side
Yo: yarnover

STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Pattern

- Row 1 (RS): With MC, k2, yo, k to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2. (4 sts incd)
Row 2: With MC, knit.
Row 3: With CC, k2, yo, k to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2. (4 sts incd)
Row 4: With CC, k2, p to m, sl m, k1, sl m, p to last 2 sts, k2.
Rep rows 1-4 for Stripe Pattern.



INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, CO 5 stitches. Knit 2 rows. Join CC1.

Set Up Row 1 (CC): K2, yo, pm, k1, pm, yo, k2. 7 sts.

Set Up Row 2 (CC): K2, p1, sl m, k1, sl m, p1, k2.

Work 72 rows in Stripe Pattern (see Stitch Guide) using CC1 (for a total of 19 CC1 stripes and 151 sts). Cut CC1 and join CC2.

Work 44 rows in Stripe Pattern using CC2 (for a total of 11 CC2 stripes and 239 sts). Cut CC2 and join CC3.

Work 32 rows in Stripe Pattern using CC3 (for a total of 8 CC3 stripes and 303 sts). Cut CC3 and join CC4.

Work 24 rows in Stripe Pattern using CC4 (for a total of 6 CC4 stripes and 353 sts). Cut CC4 and join CC5.

Work 16 rows in Stripe Pattern using CC5 (for a total of 4 CC5 stripes and 385 sts). Cut CC5.

With MC, work rows 1 and 2 of Stripe Pattern a total of 3 times, then work Row 1 again (401 sts). Bind off knitwise on WS.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.
