

Frill Seeker Twirly Scarf

Materials: 1 ball Estelle Frill Seeker
4.5mm needles (preferably with sharp tip)
Darning needle

To cast on, unfold Frill Seeker and hold it with the ball to your left. Insert needle from front to back approximately ¼” from top edge. Bring needle over yarn and insert again from front to back approximately 1 ½” to the left. Repeat this step for a total of 100 sts.

Knit five rows. Cast off loosely.

With darning needle, weave end through cast off row.

Note: To join two ends together, overlap the two ends approximately 4” and knit through both layers.

Frill Seeker Wristlets

Materials: Small amount Estelle Frill Seeker
4.5mm needles
1 skein Cascade 220

Ruffle

Cast on 6 sts with Frill Seeker. Work in st st (k1 row, p1 row) for a total of 40 rows or enough to fit around wrist. Cast off.

With Cascade 220 pick up 48 sts along the edge of ruffle and work in k1, p1 ribbing for 5”. Cast off.

Fold wristlet in half length wise. Sew top 1.5” down from cast off edge. Leave a space of 1.5” & continue sewing the rest of the wristlet together. The opening forms a hole for your thumb.
