Cable Front Sweater

Sizes: Small, medium, large Finished Measurements: 34, 38, 40" Materials: 6, (7, 8) 100g skeins Estelle Cloud Cotton 4mm needles 5mm needles stitch markers cable needle (cn) 18 sts = 4" on larger needle. Adjust needle size in order to obtain gauge. Gauge: Abbreviation: M1- make one/increase- with tip of left needle, pick up strand between needles from front to back. Knit lifted loop through the back. Cable Pattern (over 18 stitches) Rows 1, 3 ,5 and 7: (P2, K2) 4 times, P2 Row 2 and all even rows: K the K stitches, P the P stitches Row 9: P2 *sl2 sts on cn, hold in front, P1, K2 sts from cn, sl1 st on cn, hold in back, K2 sts from cn, P4, repeat from * once more Row 11: P3, sl2 sts on cn, hold in back, K2, K2 sts from cn, P4, sl2 sts on cn, hold in front, K2, K2 sts from cn. P3 Row 13, 15 and 17: as Row 1 Row 19: as Row 11 Row 21: *P2, slip 1 st on cn, hold in back, K2, P1 st from cn, slip 2 sts on cn, hold in front, P1, K2 sts from cn, repeat from * Back With smaller needles cast on 78 (86, 92) sts. K2, P2 to the last 2 sts, K2. Continue in ribbing for 3". Change to larger needles. Cont in st st until piece measures 14 (15 ¼, 16 ¼)" from cast on. Armhole Cast off 4 sts at the beg of next 2 rows. Cast off 2 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. Cast off 1 st at the beg of next 4 (6, 8) rows. 62 (68, 72) sts rem. Cont knitting in st st until back measures 17 ½ (18 ½ , 19 ½)" from cast on ending with a WS row. Change to smaller needles. K2, P2 until last 2 sts, K2. Continue in ribbing for 3". Put stitches on a holder. Front With smaller needles cast on 78 (86, 92) sts. K2. P2 to last 2 sts. K2. Continue in ribbing for 3", ending with a WS row. Change to larger needles. K30 (34, 37) sts, PM (place marker), begin cable pattern over next 18 sts beg with Row 5 (1, 1) PM, K30 (34, 37) sts. Continue as for back with cable pattern being worked between markers until back measures 17 ½ (18½, 19½)" from cast on. Change to smaller needles. K2, P2 until last 2 sts, K2. Continue in ribbing for 3". Put stitches on a holder. Join shoulders- With RS facing each other, cast off the first 12 sts together using the 3 needle bind-off . Cast off centre 38 stitches of front and back separately, cast off remaining 12 sts using 3 needle bind-off. Sleeves With smaller needles cast on 42 (46, 50) sts. K2, P2 to last 2 sts, K2. Continue in ribbing for 3", ending with a WS row. Change to larger needles and with RS facing, beg St st. Work st st for 10 cm, ending with a WS row. M1 in first and last st at each end of next row & every following 6th row 6 (7, 8) more times. 56 (62, 68) sts. Continue in st st until piece measures 13 1/2 (14, 14 1/2)" from end of rib. Sleeve Cap Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Cast off 1 st at beg of next 4 rows. Work 6 rows even. Cast off 1 st at the beg of each row until 24 sts remain. Cast off remaining stitches. Finishing: Block pieces. Sew sleeves into armholes. Sew side & sleeve seams. Weave in any ends.
