LACE SHAWL OR SCARF

This shawl and scarf were inspired by Debbie New's Scribble Lace technique.

SHAWL Materials:

1 200g skein Estelle Woolly Bully1 100g skein Estelle Arequipa12mm circular needle (any length)

Gauge is not critical for this shawl.

With Woolly Bully and 12mm needle, cast on 50 sts. Knit 1 row.

* Drop Woolly Bully (do not cut it), join Arequipa and work 5 rows of st st starting with a knit row. Slide all sts to opposite end of needle. Loosely carry Woolly Bully up side of shawl and knit 1 row. Drop Woolly Bully (do not cut), pick up Arequipa and work 5 rows of st st starting with a purl row. Slide all sts to opposite end of needle. Loosely carry Woolly Bully up side of shawl and purl 1 row. * Repeat from * until shawl measures approx 65" or desired length. Knit 1 row with Woolly Bully. Cast off loosely with Woolly Bully.

SCARF Materials:

1 200g skein Estelle Woolly Bully1 100g skein Estelle Arequipa12mm circular needle (any length)

Gauge is not critical for this scarf.

With Woolly Bully and 12mm needle, cast on 15 sts. Follow instructions for shawl until scarf measures approx 70" or desired length.
