YARN REQUIREMENTS FOR FULL SET:

Young Touch (50gm balls): 6 mos = 4, 12 mos = 5, 18 mos = 6South Pacific (100gm skeins): 6 mos = 2, 12 mos = 3, 18 mos = 3

SWEATER

Sizes: 6 mos (12 mos, 18 mos)
Finished measurements: Chest: 20 (22, 24) inches
Length: 10 (11, 12) inches

Sleeve length: 7.5 (8.75, 10.25) inches

Materials: 3 (4, 5) 50gm balls Estelle Young Touch Cotton or 2 (2, 3) 100g skeins Estelle South Pacific Cotton.

Needles: 4mm needles OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Notions: cable needle, stitch holders, stitch markers, 2 half inch buttons Gauge: 22 sts and 32 rows in Seed Stitch on 4mm needles = 4 inches/10cm

Back: Cast on 58 (62, 68) sts.

Work 5 rows in Seed St.

Next row (RS): Work 14 (15, 17) sts in Seed St as established, work row 1 of Snake Cable patt on 8 sts, work 14 (16, 18) sts in Seed St as established, work row 1 of Snake Cable patt on 8 sts, work Seed St to end.

Following row (RS): Work 14 (15, 17) sts in Seed St as established, work row 2 of Snake Cable patt on 8 sts, work 14 (16, 18) sts in Seed St as established, work row 2 of Snake Cable patt on 8 sts, work Seed St to end.

Work as established until piece measures 5.5 (6.25, 7)" from cast on edge.

Cast off 5 sts at beg next two rows. 48 (52, 58) sts rem. Cont even in patt as established until piece measures 10 (11, 12)" from cast-on edge. Cast off.

Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this pattern, however we cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical error.

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Front: Work as for back until armhole shaping is complete. Work another inch even in patt as established, ending with a WS row.

Next row (RS):Work 26 (28, 31) sts in patt. Put rem 22 (24, 26) sts on a holder for right side of neck.

Working only on these sts for the left side of neck, cont in patt until piece meas 1" from division, ending with a WS row.

Work a Buttonhole row (RS): Work to last 3 sts in patt, yo k2tog, work last st in patt.

Cont in patt, working another Buttonhole row an inch from the previous one.

Cont even in patt until piece measures 2.75 (2.75, 3)" from armhole shaping, ending with a RS row.

Next row (WS): Work 4 sts in patt then slip them to a holder, cast off 5 (5, 5) sts, work in patt to end.

Cont on these 17 (19, 21) sts, dec 1 st at the start of every following WS row 6 (7, 7) times. 11 (12, 14) sts rem. If necessary, work even until front measures same length as back. Cast off in patt.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn & pick up 4 sts along the wrong side of the base of the left neck placket, then work across the 22 (24, 26) sts of the right from the holder. Work even in patt, working the 4 picked up sts in Seed St, until piece measures 2.75 (2.75, 3)" from armhole shaping, ending with a WS row.

Next row (RS): Work 4 sts in patt, then slip then to a holder, cast off 5 (5, 5) sts, work in patt to end.

Cont on these 17 (19, 21) sts, dec 1 st at the start of every foll RS row 6 (7, 7) times. 11 (12, 14) sts rem. If necessary, work even until front measures same length as back. Cast off in patt.

Collar: Sew both shoulder seams.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn, & work the 4 sts from the right front holder in Seed St patt as established. Pick up 5 (5, 5) along cast off at right front neckline, 8 (9, 10) sts along right front neck slope, 26 (28, 28) sts along back neck, 8 (9, 10) down left front neck slope, 5 (5, 5) along cast off at left front neckline, & work across 4 sts from left front holder. 60 (64, 66) sts total. Place markers 17 (18, 19) sts in from either end.

Work 3 rows in Seed St. Note: If you need to, increase a stitch so that the Seed St pattern continues unbroken across the plackets, and move the markers to accomodate as necessary.

Increase row (RS): *Work in patt to st before marker in patt, kfb, slip marker, kfb; rep from * once more, work in patt to end.

Work an even row, working increased sts into patt. Repeat the above two rows twice more.

Work even in patt until collar meas 2" from pick up. Cast off in patt.

Sleeves: With RS facing, rejoin yarn & pick up 50 (52, 56) sts along full length of armhole edge – both the front and back. Row 1 (WS): Work 21 (22, 24) sts in Seed St, k2 p4 k2, work to end in Seed St.

Row 2 (RS): Work 21 (22, 24) in Seed St as established, work Row 1 of Snake Cable Pattern, work to end in Seed St. Work 5 (5, 7) more rows in patt.

Dec row (RS): K2tog, cont in patt to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Work 7 (7, 9) rows even.

Cont as established, working a dec row every 8 (8, 8) rows 5 (7, 8) more times, to 38 (36, 38) sts.

Smallest size only: cont in pattern, work a dec row followed by 5 even rows, & work 1 more dec row. 34 sts.

All Sizes: Work even as necessary until sleeve measures 7 (8.25, 9.75)".

Work 5 rows Seed St. Cast off in patt.

Finishing: Sew side & sleeve seams. Sew buttons on right front to match buttonholes. Weave in all ends.

HAT

Sizes: newborn-6 mos (6-12 mos, 12-18 mos)

Finished measurements: Circumference: 14 (15, 16)".

Materials: 1 50gm balls Estelle Young Touch or 1 100gm skein Estelle South Pacific Needles: 4mm double-pointed needles OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Notions: cable needle, stitch markers

Gauge: 22 sts and 32 rows in Seed Stitch on 4mm needles = 4 inches/10cm

Hat: Cast 72 (78, 84) sts onto a single needle. Distribute sts on three needles & join to work in the round, being careful not to twist. Place a marker to indicate the beginning of the round.

Inside cuff round: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of round.

Repeat inside cuff round until piece measures 1" from cast on edge.

Turning round: Purl.

Establish placement of cables & inc for body: *[K1 p1] 2 (3, 3) times, kfb, [k1 p1] 3 (2, 3) times, kfb, [k1 p1] 2 (3, 3) times, work Round 1 of Snake Cable patt (in the round version); rep from * twice more. 78 (84, 90) sts.

Work as established until hat measures 5.5 (5.5, 6)" from turning round. Ensure your Seed St panels start with a p st on the final round.

Dec round 1: *[K2tog, p2tog] 4 (5, 5) times, k2tog 1 (0, 1) times; cont cable as established; rep from * twice more. 51 (54, 57) sts.

Dec round 2: *[P2tog, k2tog] 2 (2, 2) times, p1 1 (0, 0) times, p2tog 0 (1, 1) times, p1 0 (0, 1) times; cont cable as established; rep from * twice more. 39 (39, 42) sts.

Dec round 3: *K2tog, p2tog, k1 (k1, k2tog); cont cable as established; rep from * twice more. 33 (33, 33) sts.

Dec round 4: *S2kpsso, cont cable as established; rep from * twice more. 27 (27, 27) sts.

Dec round 5: *P1, p2tog, k4, p2tog; rep from * twice more. 21 (21, 21) sts.

Dec round 6: *K1, p1, k2tog, ssk, p1; rep from * twice more. 15 (15, 15) sts.

Brim: With RS facing, reattach yarn, and pick up 16 (18, 20) sts along the turning ridge below one of the three Seed St panels.

Work 2 rows even in Seed St.

Next row (WS): K2tog, work to last 2 sts in Seed St, ssk.

Work 1 row even.

Repeat the last 2 rows until 12 sts rem. Cast off in pattern.

Finishing: Cut yarn, leaving an 8" tail. Draw through rem sts & fasten securely. Fold ribbed cuff under towards the inside of the hat at turning round, & whipstich in place. Weave in all ends.

BOOTEES

Sizes: newborn-6 mos (6-12 mos)

Finished measurements: Foot length: 3.75 (4.25) inches

Materials: 1 50gm balls Estelle Young Touch or 1 100gm skein Estelle South Pacific Needles: 4mm needles OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE, 4mm crochet hook

Notions: cable needle, stitch markers

Gauge: 22 sts and 32 rows in Seed Stitch on 4mm needles = 4 inches/10cm

Bootees: Cast on 24 (28) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Work 8 (10) sts in Seed St, work Row 1 of Cable Snake pattern, work 8 (10) sts in Seed St.

Row 2 (WS): Work 8 (10) sts in Seed St, work Row 2 of Cable Snake pattern, work 8 (10) sts in Seed St.

Cont as established for 8 (10) more rows.

Size Small only: Row 11 (RS): K1 (k1 yo k2tog) 3 times, k4, (k1 yo k2tog) 3 times, k1.

Size Large only: Row 13 (RS): K1 (k1 yo k2tog) 3 times, k2tog yo, k4, (yo k2tog k1) 4 times.

Following row (WS): Work 8 (10) sts in Seed St, work Cable Snake patt as established, work 8 (10) sts in Seed St. Work 1 more RS row in patt.

Next row (WS): Work 16 (19) sts in patt, turn. Place rem sts 8 (9) from end of row on holder for left side of foot.

First instep row (RS): Cast on 1 st, work 8 (10) in patt, cast on 1 more st. 10 (12) sts. Turn. Place rem 8 (9) sts on holder for right side of foot.

Keeping first & last st in St st, work in patt on centre 10 (12) sts for 12 (14) more rows, ending after a WS row. Cut yarn. Rejoin yarn with RS facing to sts of left side of foot. Work across 8 (9) sts on a holder, pick up 8 sts along side of instep, work across 10 (12) sts of instep, pick up 8 sts along side of instep, & work across 8 (9) sts on right side of foot from second holder. 42 (46) sts.

Next row (WS): Work 16 (17) sts in Seed St, work 10 (12) instep sts in patt, work to end of row in seed st.

Decrease row (RS): Work 15 (17) sts in patt, k2tog, work 8 sts in patt, k2tog, work in patt to end. 40 (44) sts.

Following row (WS): Work Seed St across entire row.

Work 5 more rows in Seed St.

Sole row 1 (RS): K1 k2tog, k13 (15) sts, k2tog, k4, ssk, k13 (15) sts, ssk, k1.

Sole row 2 (WS): Knit

Sole row 3 (RS): K1 k2tog, k12 (14) sts, k2tog, k2, ssk, work k12 (14) sts, ssk, k1.

Sole row 5 (RS): K1 k2tog, k11 (13) sts, k2tog, ssk, k11 (13) sts, ssk, k1.

Work one more WS row. Cast off.

Finishing: Sew seam for back & underside of foot. Crochet a 14" chain & run through eyelet holes for a tie. Weave in all ends.
