

## Lang Lanalux Scarf or Shawl

### Scarf

Materials: 2 25 gram balls Lang Lanalux  
7 mm needles

Gauge is not critical for this scarf.

Cast on 28 sts.

Row 1: \*k2tog, (yo) twice, sl 1, k 1, pss0; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \*k1, (k1, p1) into double yo, k1; rep from \* to end of row.

Note: for a loose ladder effect – p into the front of the double yo, for a tighter ladder result p into the back of the double yo.

Repeat these two rows until scarf measures approximately 45” or desired length. Cast off loosely. Block the scarf.

### Shawl

Materials: 4 25 gram balls Lang Lanalux  
7 mm needle

Cast on 7 sts. Knit one row.

Row 1: k2, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, k2 (place a marker at the centre st if desired.)

Row 2 and all alt rows: Purl

Row 3: K2, yo, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, yo, k2

Row 5: K2, yo, k5, yo, k1, yo, k5, yo, k2

Row 7: K2, yo, k7, yo, k1, yo, k7, yo, k2

Row 9: K2, yo, k9, yo, k1, yo, k9, yo, k2

Row 11: K2, yo, k11, yo, k1, yo, k11, yo, k2

Continue increasing 4 sts each right side row as above until there are 219 sts on needle.

Next row: K2, yo, \*k2tog, yo, rep from \* to the centre st, yo, k1, yo, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2. Purl one row. Cast off loosely. Block shawl.

To make a longer shawl, continue increasing until desired length. You may have to purchase additional balls of Lanalux.
